The last three live performances at the Theatre have either exceeded expectations or sold out. There is a clear demand for live performance at the Majestic Theatre.

Beginning in November 2011 Pomona Progress.Art.Tourism Inc., the non-profit association who are owners of the Majestic, underwent a total change of Committee and Board.

Several of the 'new' Committee have returned from the team who spearheaded the refurbishment of the Theatre over 2005/2007. We are supported by advisors very experienced in the entertainment industry and others who are vitally interested in the future of the association's projects, a particular concern at the moment being the Majestic Theatre. All of these people live locally and are committed to carrying out the promises made to the funding providers who stepped forward to save the building. We are all working on a voluntary basis, and will welcome other volunteers who would like to be involved. We have a new volunteer rewards incentive scheme which we would be happy to talk to you about.

SILENT FILM

We intend to carry on the tradition of silent films. Ron West has opted for a well-earned retirement, and will be replaced by other organists, including talented young musician Chris Rose who has already accompanied a number of films on the Compton organ. However, much as we value this art form, silent film aficionados make up a small demographic of the population and we need to return to our original premise of multi-purpose entertainment if we are to survive financially and serve the whole community as originally intended.

FLEXIBILITY

We will soon have a fully revised rate card available. We intend to be as flexible as possible in order to achieve a symbiotic and financially viable experience for all of us, so if you have a proposition for a live performance to put forward please contact us. You will be welcomed, listened to and if at all possible, accommodated. All options will be considered.

We are also looking to compile a database of entertainers interested in working on weddings, community and corporate events etc. for both internal purposes and referrals.

We are working on an exciting transformation of the land area at the back of the Theatre, and will soon apply for funding to transform it into an aesthetically pleasing al fresco area designed for outdoor audiences to make the most of the Theatre's ability to open up the back of the stage for viewing from the rear. This will literally open up doors to new opportunities for many live entertainment genres. We see weekend afternoons as an appealing prospect for this new endeavour. We are liquor licensed and have a commercial kitchen.
